The Society was formed in 1964 to encourage and promote interest in the study of the history of Durham County, particularly during those recent centuries when it was playing a major part in the economic and industrial growth of the country, and also making its individual contribution to the industrial, social, religious and political development of Britain. The area covered by the Society's work is that of the historic **County Palatine** - the area between the Tyne and the Tees, including the major urban areas now in Gateshead, Sunderland, South Tyneside, Hartlepool, Stockton on Tees and Darlington local authority areas.

The Society arranges talks at the City Theatre in Durham in spring and autumn and issues a range of publications.

The Journal [formerly the Bulletin], now published once a year and available free to members, includes original contributions on Durham's history, articles on sources and reviews of books.

The Documentary Series, also issued free to members, presents a wide range of edited documents illustrating aspects of the county's past in transcript and/or facsimile form.

More important works of original research on a wide range of local topics are published as ***Occasional Papers*** and are offered to members at reduced prices. A list of the publications available is kept up to date on the Society's website.

Notes of Gift Aid

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Durham County Local History Society reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for every pound you give).
2. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the Membership Secretary of the Society.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or Capital Gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your Declaration.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment Tax Return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Membership Secretary of the Society, or ask you local Tax Office for Leaflet IR65.
